The Informant concedes he was a party to some of the inappropriate behaviours and did not raise any issues contemporaneously as he did not necessarily view it as a broader issue at the time. The Informant advises that all alleged documentary evidence of inappropriate behaviours (such as videos and/or pictures) were received from Mr Winn via Facebook Messenger Chat (but this was in direct messages and did not involve other persons).
